I. <u>Overview</u>

This information should include how this one feature of the annual program was organized and conducted and what results were secured. FFA members and advisors attending the conference may thus secure information of value in developing more effective chapters in the state. Any project of an educational nature which contributes directly to training for success in a farming or agribusiness occupation may be portrayed.

This is a State event.

II. AFNR Career Cluster Content Standards

III. Event Rules

- A. To be judged, an entry must be made on the State Leadership Conference online entry form by deadline posted by the Iowa FFA Association.
- B. All material is to be displayed on panels not over five feet high at the highest point above the table and not exceeding the length of six feet.
- C. The table space in front of the panel may be used.
- D. Exhibits, which have a base below tabletop level, also must be on a panel not over five feet high and six feet wide.
- E. Table skirts may be used, however, no chapter activity exhibit materials may be displayed on the skirts (or below table level if a table skirt is used) except an official chapter FFA banner; however, the banner is not required.
- F. The chairperson of the chapter activity event will determine if the exhibit is eligible. Thus, this is not a responsibility of the judges.
- G. All material must be for a period not exceeding twelve months immediately preceding the State Leadership Conference.
- H. A copy of the chapter's Program of Activities, that includes the specific activity featured in the display, must be included with the exhibit.
- I. The exhibit should emphasize a single chapter activity, not a group of activities.
- J. The exhibit must be in place and removed according to the times distributed by the Iowa FFA to all entered chapters.
- K. No audio may be used as a portion of the display. Video is acceptable, but it must be silent.
