2024 National FFA Convention and Expo, October 23 – 26

INDIANAPOLIS, IN--The 97th National FFA Convention & Expo held its annual in-person convention beginning October 23rd and concluded on October 26th. More than 70,000 FFA members and guests from throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands attended this year's event.

The convention and expo kicked off in Indianapolis, Indiana on Wednesday, October 23rd. Seven general sessions were held at Lucas Oil Stadium. A special ceremony was held on Saturday, October 26th where American FFA Degrees, the highest degree for an FFA member, were bestowed upon more than 4,800 members.

The Iowa FFA Association had representation from more than 3,000 attendees involved in all facets of the event. The following is a summary of results and accomplishments of Iowa FFA members in their respective national events.

Kanyon Huntington, Retired 2023-2024 National FFA Central Region Vice President

Kanyon Huntington, a Political Science major at Iowa State University and FFA member from the East Union FFA chapter, completed his term as National Central Region Vice President. He delivered his retiring address titled "The Comparison Trap" during the third session of the conference on Thursday, October 24th.

Huntington is the fourth FFA member from Iowa to be elected to National Office since 2013 and served the Iowa FFA Association as the 2021-22 State Reporter.

Agriscience Fair National Finalists

The Agriscience Fair is for FFA members who are interested in the science and technology of agriculture. Students can compete in 36 divisions across 6 systems areas: Animal; Environmental & Natural Resources; Food Products & Processing; Plant; Power, Structural, & Technical; and Social. Divisions are set based on junior (grades 7-8), intermediate (grades 9-10) and senior (grades 11-12) projects and whether the project is conducted by an individual or a pair.
